In December 2023 Consolidated Uranium became a subsidiary of IsoEnergy Ltd. These claims are now nearing the end of their second term and require assessment work. The geophysical survey we have planned is to test/ validate/ follow up on previous field programs on the property including historical drilling and geophysical targets.


